CELEBRATION AT SILVER MIST AVERAGES \$1758

The Celebration at Silver Mist Sale was held on Saturday, May 5, 2018, at the farm at Ashville, Ohio. Owners Dallas Rynd and Judy Wolford hosted a cattle viewing and social hour on Friday evening prior to the sale. A luncheon and the sale took place on Saturday, a beautiful spring day with a large crowd of friends and fellow dairy breeders in attendance. The sale averaged \$1758 on 90 live lots.

Topping the sale at \$19,000 was Lot 74, MS Apple MS Adra-Red-ET, classified VG 87 at three years. Stylish and with a beautiful udder, she had recently calved and looked ready for the upcoming shows. She was the Reserve Intermediate Champion at the 2017 Ohio State Fair Red and White Show. Sired by Ladys-Manor Olympian, she is the daughter of the Excellent 96 4E KHW Regiment Apple-Red. She was purchased by Glamourview, Gene Iager, Fulton, Maryland.

Selling for \$8400 to Adam Derr, Danson, Pennsylvania, was Lot 1, Greenlea BW Mar-Red, a five year old classified EX 92. She was the first place Four Year Old and Reserve Grand Champion at the Ohio Spring Expo Red and White Show in 2017. Sired by Hylite Barbwire-Red-ET, her dam was Greenlea Rub Marlene-Red-ET EX 94 3E and winner of several All-American awards.

Lot 75, We-Three HYP Adriatico-Red, a summer yearling, sold for \$5600 To Glamourview, Gene Iager, Fulton,

Maryland. Sired by Mr Hotstuffs Hypnotic-ET, she is the daughter of the top selling Lot 74, MS Apple MS Adra-Red-ET.

Lot 3, Silver-Mist AD Maritage-Red, a spring calf sired by Mr Ansly Addiction-P-Red-ET sold for \$4000 to Franchise, Dusty and Nicole Schirm, Ashville, Ohio. Her dam is the second high seller, Greenlea BW Mar-Red-ET EX 92.

The high selling Brown Swiss at \$6000 was Lot 88, Silver-Mist Bosephus Tassel, a spring yearling sired by Jobo Wonder Bosephus-ET. Her dam is a V85 Braiden daughter from a cow family with several high scoring dams. She was purchased by Madison Pitstick, South Solon, Ohio.

The high selling Jersey was Lot 76, Ahlem Prince Neva 3317, classified VG-88%. She sold for \$1600 to Bart Busey, Canal Winchester, Ohio. She is a daughter of Windhavens Visionary Prince from a VG-83% daughter of Sweetie Plus latolas Bold.

Volume buyer was Silver Creek Dairy Farm LLC, Forest, Ohio, who purchased 12 lots. Cattle sold to Pennsylvania, Maryland , Indiana and Ohio.
