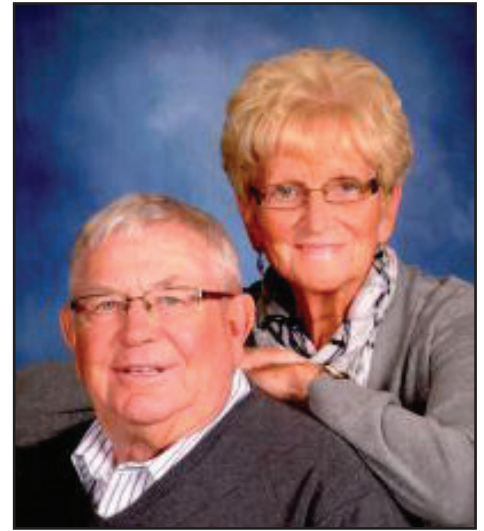


# Martha Ann Davis (1935-2021)
